## Coming Soon: A Larger Selection of Movies and Documentaries with Kanopy

A new film streaming service will soon be making its way to our collection: Kanopy, where you can watch award-winning documentaries and movies commercial-free. Can't make it to the library because of inclement weather? Want a larger selection than what we already offer? Need something you can watch directly from your phone, without the need for a DVD or Blu-ray player? Kanopy is a convenient alternative. There is even a kids section with Sesame Street, Berenstain Bears, story time, language-learning videos, and more.

You can check out up to eight titles per week. To get to Kanopy, visit our website at [www.owenlib.org](http://www.owenlib.org) and click on the Kanopy icon. This will prompt you for your library card number. If you are logging in for the first time, you will need to create an account. To do this, click on Sign Up in the upper right corner. You have the option to log in with Google or Facebook (you will be prompted for your username and password for these accounts) or create a Kanopy account, which requires your first and last name, email address, and the creation of a password. Once you've successfully done this, the collection is yours to explore! In the upper right corner, there is a number to help you keep track of how many more films you can view in a particular week.

Starting July 13<sup>th</sup>**

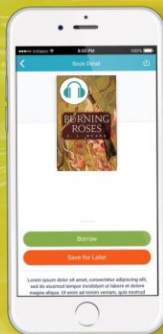
