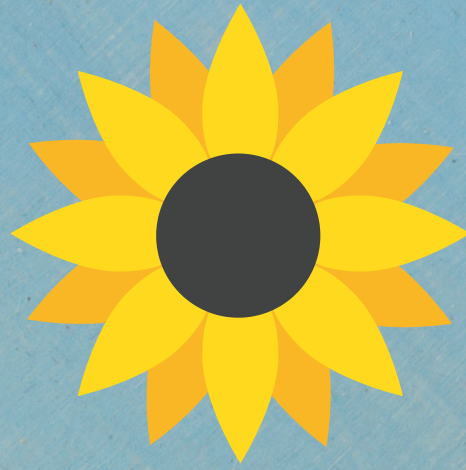

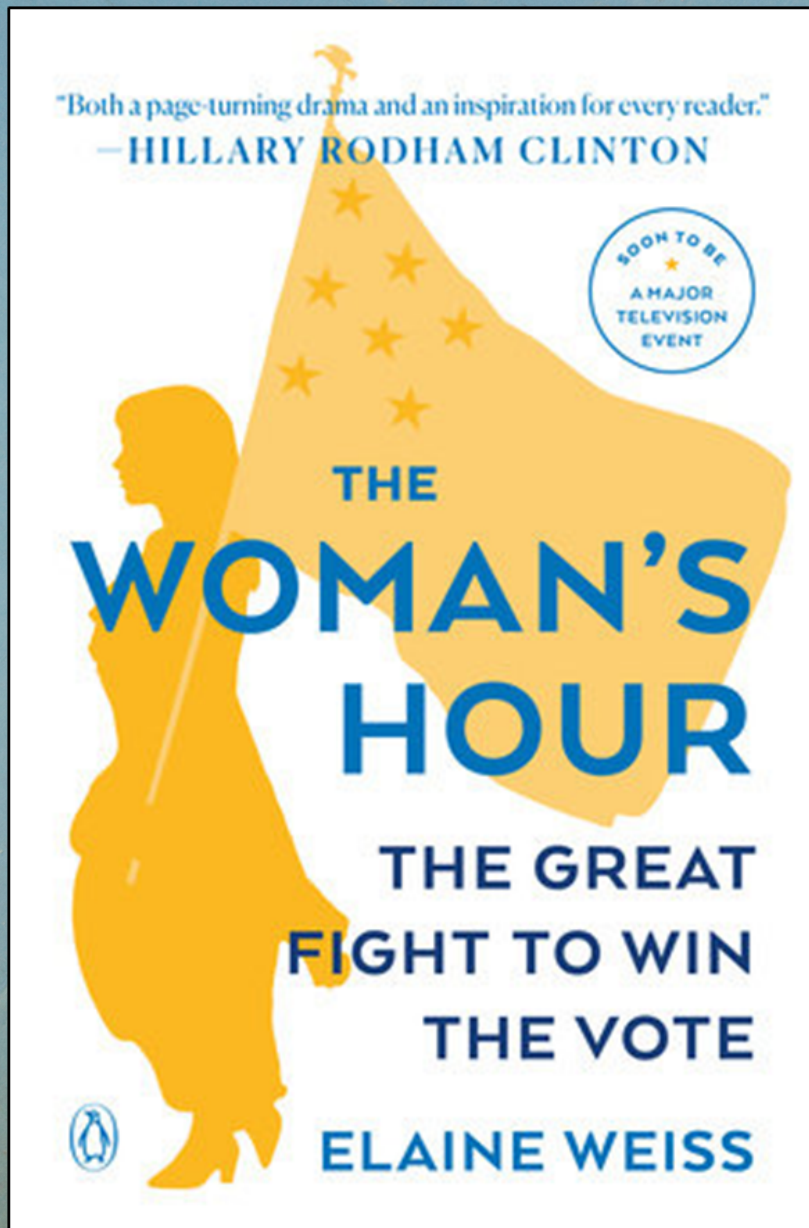


.....***New at the OCPL***.....

First LTAI: Women's Suffrage Book Discussion Program at OCPL



Join us on June 2nd at 1:00 p.m. in the Community Room, where OCPL will be hosting the first Let's Talk About It: Women's Suffrage book discussion program with Dr. Janine Giordano Drake, Clinical Assistant Professor in the Department of History at I.U. This program was made possible thanks to a grant from Let's Talk About It: Women's Suffrage, an initiative of the American Library Association, offered with support from the National Endowment for the Humanities. The first book we will be talking about is *The Woman's Hour: The Great Fight to Win the Vote* by Elaine Weiss, which takes place in August 1920. It was an election year, and the stakes were high: Tennessee was the last state needed to ratify the 19th amendment for it to become official. An intense political showdown unfolded in Nashville that summer. Amongst political and economic barriers, suffragists also faced off against women who considered suffrage a moral issue and racists who didn't want black women to vote.

We'll be examining these talking points and more, so feel free to join in the discussion!

Garden Boxes for the Library!!



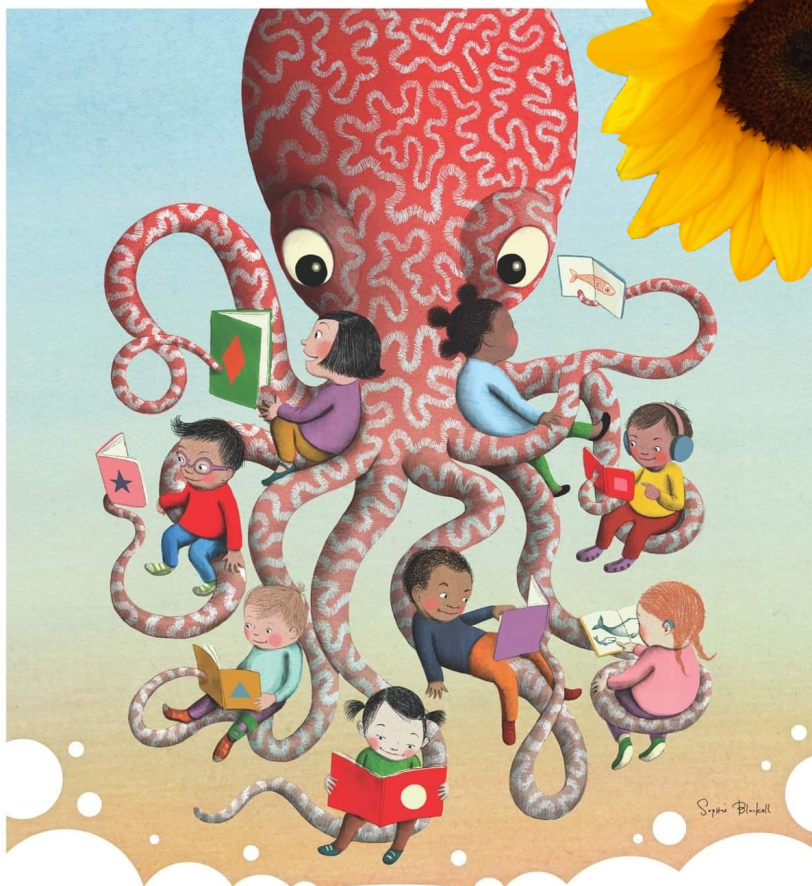
The Owen County Public Library is creating an "Outdoor Classroom", for library programs. For this we need Garden Boxes :)
